Detailed Fiscal Analysis

Potential minimal costs to the state include changing letterhead and other publications with the Great Seal printed on it. Seals mentioned in the bill include the Supreme Court, the Court of Appeals, the Court of Common Pleas, and the Probate Court. Furthermore, changes may have to be made to seals for certain state offices such as the Secretary of State, Auditor of State, the Treasurer of the State, the Lieutenant Governor and the Attorney General. However, if as a result of this bill, major replacements were required, such as changing of the seal on the rotunda in the Statehouse or in front of the steps of the Statehouse, costs may substantially increase.
