# **Fiscal Note & Local Impact Statement**

**Bill**: Am. H.B. 113 of the 130th G.A. **Date**: January 30, 2014

Status: As Passed by the House Sponsor: Reps. Antonio and Henne

Contents: Authorizes school districts and chartered nonpublic schools to excuse from high school physical

education students who participate in a school-sponsored athletic club

## **State Fiscal Highlights**

### **Local Fiscal Highlights**

No direct fiscal effect on political subdivisions.

### **Detailed Fiscal Analysis**

Current law authorizes a school district or chartered nonpublic school to adopt a policy to excuse from the high school physical education requirement (one-half unit) students who, during high school, participate in (1) interscholastic athletics, marching band, or cheerleading for at least two full seasons or (2) Junior ROTC for two full school years. The bill adds to this list students who participate in a school-sponsored athletic club for two full seasons. Students excused from the physical education requirement must complete one-half unit of instruction in another course. The bill is not likely to have a significant fiscal effect on either the state or school districts.
