State Fiscal Highlights

No direct fiscal effect on the state.

Local Fiscal Highlights

 There is a potential gain in revenues as a result of the increased number of potential violations, but it is unlikely to exceed minimal as the offenses in the bill are secondary traffic offenses.

Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill modifies the law related to graduated driver's licenses by increasing the age at which a probationary driver's license holder can be without being subject to certain driving restrictions. Given that the bill increases the number of drivers subject to the driving restrictions outlined in it, local law enforcement could see a gain in fine revenue. Any increase is dependent on the number of violations but, given that the offense is a secondary traffic offense, it is unlikely that a gain in revenues would be more than minimal.
