### Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill permits an owner of a registered historical motor vehicle to operate the vehicle on public roads and highways to and from a location where maintenance is performed on the vehicle. Current law limits the operation of a motor vehicle with historical license plates to participation in club activities, exhibitions, tours, parades, and other similar uses. There is no specific penalty associated with driving a vehicle with historical license plates for a purpose other than those listed and the bill is unlikely to have any fiscal effect.
