Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill authorizes pharmacists and pharmacy interns to administer immunizations recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), permits the State Board of Pharmacy to adopt rules reflecting changes in those recommendations, and lowers to seven the minimum age of a person to whom a pharmacist or pharmacy intern may administer an immunization. These provisions will not create any discernible ongoing licensing and regulatory costs for the State Board of Pharmacy.
