## **Fiscal Note & Local Impact Statement**

**Bill**: S.B. 283 of the 130th G.A. **Date**: April 9, 2014

**Status**: As Passed by the Senate **Sponsor**: Sen. Bacon

Contents: Increases the term length of the chairperson of the Governor's Council on People with

Disabilities and requires the Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities Agency to provide

meeting space, equipment, and furniture to the Council

#### **State Fiscal Highlights**

No direct fiscal effect on the state.

#### **Local Fiscal Highlights**

No direct fiscal effect on political subdivisions.

### **Detailed Fiscal Analysis**

The bill allows a member and the chairperson of the Governor's Council on People with Disabilities to remain in office after the member or chairperson's term has expired until the individual's successor takes office. The bill allows the chairperson to serve for a two-year term and prohibits the chairperson from succeeding himself or herself. The chairperson currently serves a one-year term and may succeed himself or herself not more than one time. There should be no additional costs to the Council related to these provisions.

Additionally, the bill requires the Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities Agency (OOD) to provide meeting space, equipment, and furniture for the Council. OOD does not anticipate any additional costs related to this requirement.
