Sub. H.B. 25

126th General Assembly (S. Judiciary Civil Justice)

The committee amended the bill to provide that when an individual is elected to fill the vacant office of an active or retired employee member of a state retirement board, the successor member holds office until the first day of the new term that follows the next board election that occurs not less than 90 days after the successor member's election; to specify that the additional members to a state retirement board that are appointed by the Governor pursuant to Section 5 of Sub. S.B. 133 of the 125th General Assembly hold office until the first day of the new term that follows the next board election that occurs not less than 90 days after the successor member's election; to provide that the retirant member of the School Employees Retirement Board must hold office through June 30, 2005, as directed in Section 6 of Am. H.B. 10 of the 126th General Assembly, and to declare an emergency.
