Eliminates the specific reference in current law to the type of certificate a pilot must hold ("the grade of private pilot or higher") in order to carry passengers and establishes instead a general prohibition against a person carrying passengers in an aircraft unless the person has a certificate issued by the United States that authorizes the holder to carry passengers and the person is carrying any passengers in accordance with the applicable certificate requirements.
