Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments*

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Sub. H.B. 113

130th General Assembly (As Reported by S. Education)

Requires students who participate in *any* of the activities that qualify for excusal from high school physical education, including activities provided for under current law, to demonstrate competency in the physical education standards adopted by the State Board of Education in order to be excused.

Prohibits a school district board of education and governing authority of a chartered nonpublic school that adopts such an excusal policy from requiring a student to complete any physical education course as a condition to graduate, so long as the student demonstrates success in meeting the benchmarks contained in the physical education standards and in other wellness measures established by the State Board.

Permits the school district board or governing authority to designate persons to determine whether a student demonstrates success in the benchmarks.
